- ⌚ Must have a C average or better.
- ⌚ Must be devoid of any school suspensions due to alcohol, tobacco or other drug issues.

Write an essay between 750-1000 words about alcohol, tobacco or other drugs. (MUST BE TYPED) This can be on why you have chosen not to use them, how someone in your life has been affected by them, why it is important for communities to address these issues, or similar themes.

The application and essay must be postmarked by the **second Monday in April of each year.**

Awards will be announced by **the second week in May of each year.**
